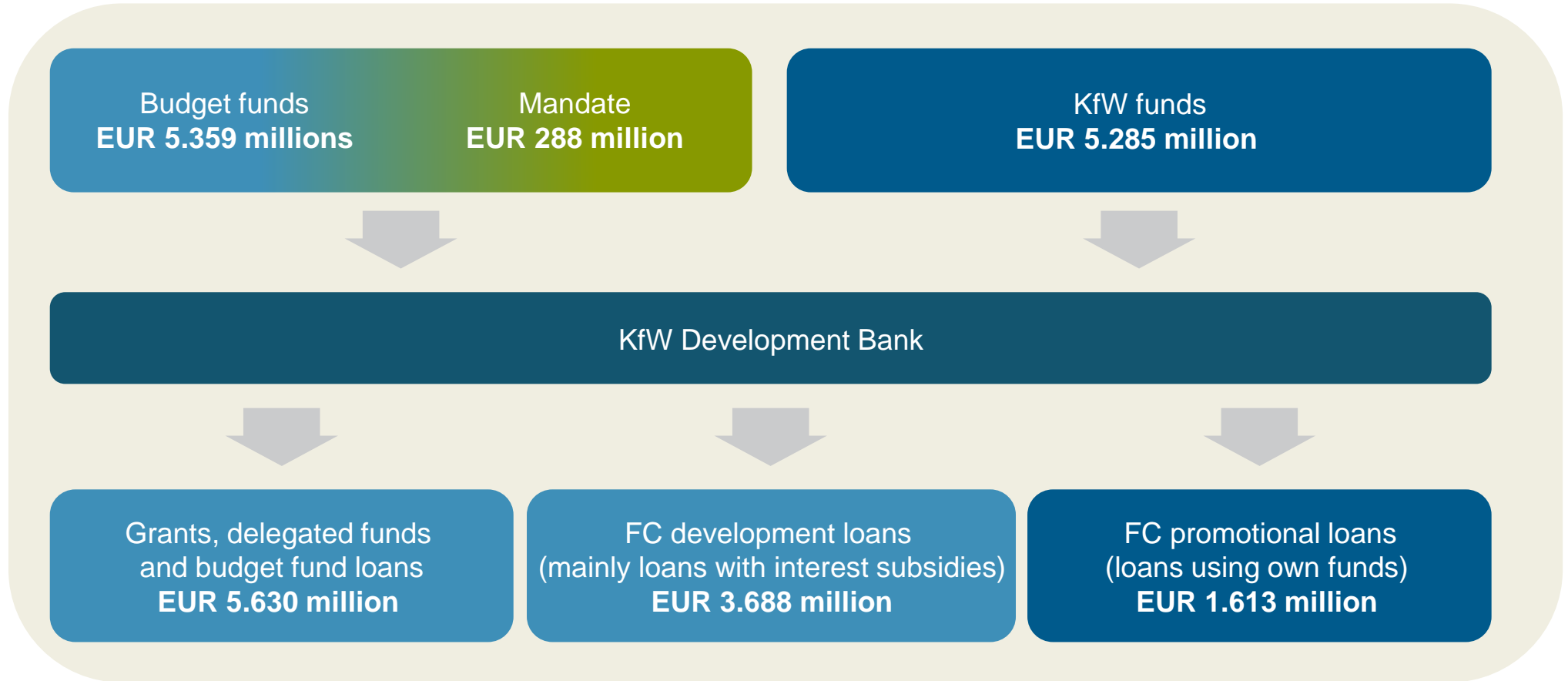

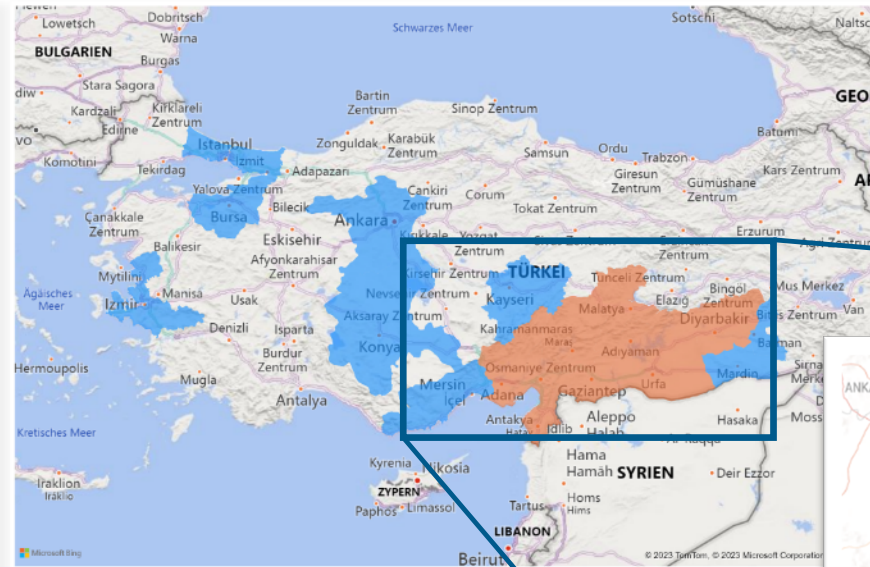

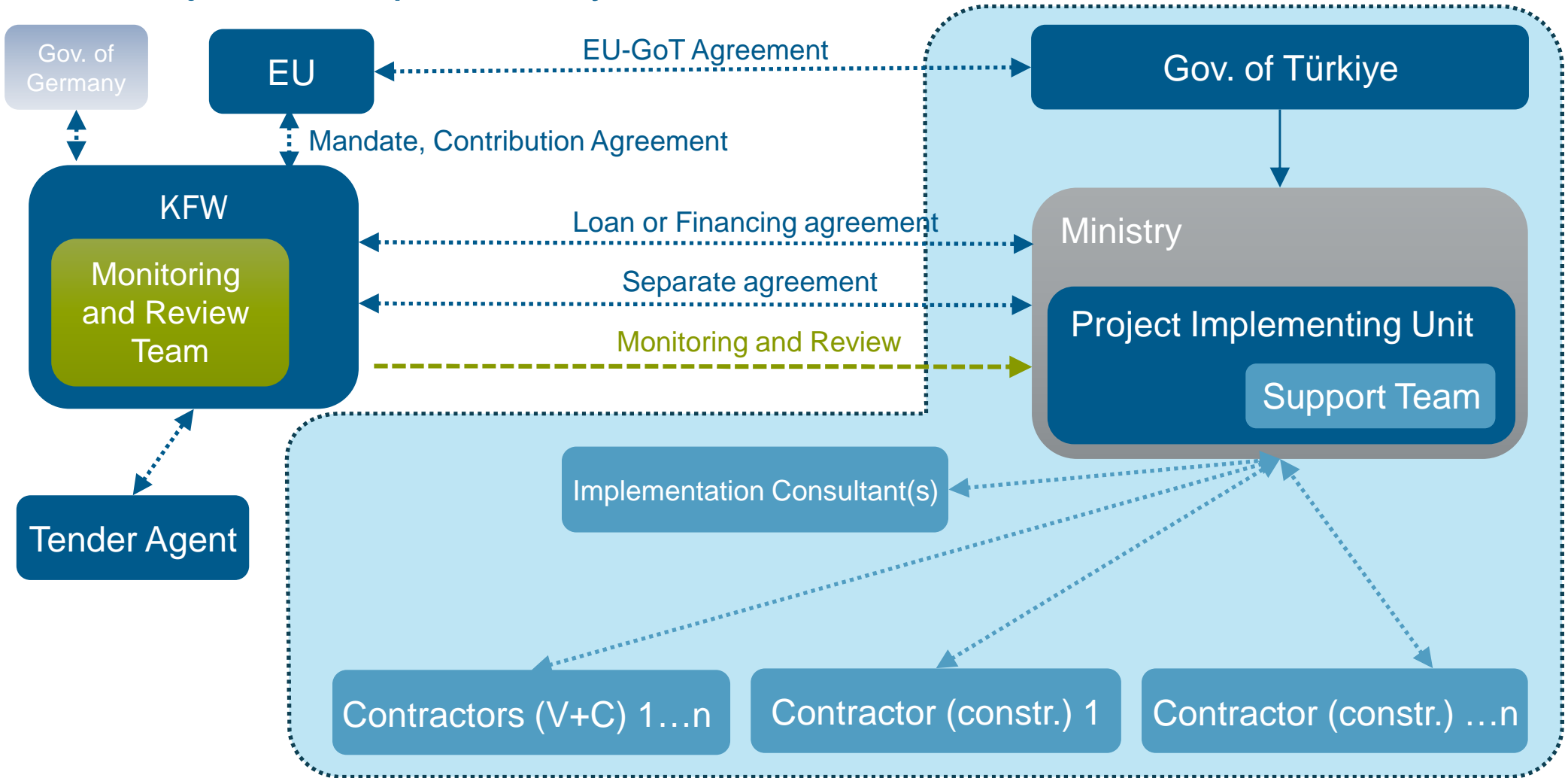

Istanbul Seismic Risk Mitigation and Emergency Preparedness project (ISMEP)

- Partner: Istanbul Project Coordination Unit (IPCU) within the Governorship of Istanbul
- Retrofitting/ reconstruction of public buildings in Istanbul for earthquake resistance
- Strengthening capacities for disaster risk management and emergency response
- Volume: EUR 250 million promotional loan
- Implementation Period: 2016-2024
